How to Become a Patient.

- No health insurance (Private or Work-Sponsored insurance, Medicare, Medicaid, or VA Benefits)
- Permanently reside in Mecklenburg County
- Low Income (200% Federal Poverty Level Household Income)
- Not receiving primary care through other free clinics, Carolinas Medical Center Sliding Scale Clinics, or C.W. Williams Community Health Center

MATTHEWS FREE MEDICAL CLINIC

Matthews Free Medical Clinic is a free medical clinic that provides quality healthcare to low income, uninsured patients of Matthews, NC, and surrounding areas, including Mecklenburg and Union Counties. Staffed by volunteer physicians and nurses, a paid nurse manager, a paid part-time clinic director, and lay people, the clinic provides well patient care, treatment of chronic diseases such as hypertension and diabetes, and gynecological exams.

Patient Requirements:

- Patients must live in Mecklenburg or Union County
- Be 6 – 64 years old
- Not have Medicaid, VA or private insurance
- Individuals seeking assistance must call 704.841.8882 to get details concerning the next new patient screening dates and times.

Note: MFMC re-certifies patients every 12 months from their starting certification date. Patients must bring your current year's tax return, most recent pay stub, recent utility bill and disability statement, if applicable.

What to bring (plus one copy additional of each)

- Picture ID
- Social Security Card for all household members.
- Two consecutive Payroll stubs (most recent) or letter from employer
- Utility bills with your name on it
- Mortgage statement
- Two consecutive bank statements
- Current year's tax return

- Disability statement, if applicable
- Food stamp letter, if applicable
- Unemployment benefits letter, if applicable
- Child support, if applicable

* No originals will be accepted. Copies cannot be made at the clinic. Applicants must bring copies to the eligibility screening or the MFMC will be unable to process the application.
